In 2024, the AARP Community Challenge is accepting applications across three different grant opportunities:

	FLAGSHIP GRANTS Flagship Grants offer a broad opportunity for communities to apply for funding across several categories.	CAPACITY- BUILDING MICROGRANTS Capacity-Building Microgrants combine grant funding with expert support and AARP publications.	DEMONSTRATION GRANTS Demonstration Grants encourage replication of promising local efforts in communities nationwide.
GRANT AMOUNTS	Average grant: \$11,900 Flagship Grants have ranged from several hundred dollars (\$500) for smaller, short-term activities to tens of thousands of dollars (\$50,000) for larger projects.	\$2,500 grants Microgrants will include additional resources, such as: webinars, cohort learning opportunities, up to 2 hours of one-on-one coaching with leading national organizations, and AARP publications	While there is not a defined budget range for this category, similar projects tend to fall between \$10,000-\$20,000 and will not exceed \$50,000
