Additionally, we learned about the Oklahoma Life Expectancy Project, the purpose of which is to help explain why the life expectancy of Native people in Oklahoma declined by 2.4 years between 2000 and 2019.

As our communities observe National American Indian and Alaska Native Heritage Month together, we hope you will take some time to celebrate all that the Coalition has accomplished thus far.

Your role in our work is vital, and your ongoing advocacy efforts will help make sure that more resources are allocated to meet the needs of Native urban Elders.
